AGES Society Art Prize

The Australasian Gynaecological Endoscopy and Surgery (AGES) Society are proud to announce that the annual AGES Society Art Prize will be held once again for submissions in 2023, for the 2024 - 2025 event calendar.

Submissions for a **\$10,000** cash prize will be considered by the AGES Society Board for 3 commissioned artworks to be the covers of our three annual meeting brochures.

The three works will be auctioned at the AGES Society Annual Scientific Meeting held in March 2023, with all proceeds going to a charity of the Board's choice. Our previous winners have been Fiona Omeenyo (2016/2017), Carrie Pitcher (2017/2018), Shannon Hamilton (2018/2019), Lucila Zentner (2019/2020), Sally Ann Harrison (2020/2021) and Cristina Metelli (2021/2022), Matthew Gillett (203/2024) whose three works were used to promote the meetings, are on our website. The artwork is distributed through various print media to a circulation of more than 6,000 doctors and health professionals. Matthew's works will be auctioned at the upcoming AGES Annual Scientific Meeting 2024, which will be held on the Gold Coast, March 2024.

AGES Society Art Prize is judged on a variety of criteria, including but not limited to; creativity and originality; composition and design; technique and craftsmanship; and; interpretation and clarity of a concept.

Terms and Conditions of entry:

- 1. Artists must be an Australian or New Zealand resident
- 2. The winning artist will be required to produce three commissioned works based on the meeting theme & brief for conferences in July/August 2024, October 2024 and March 2025. Briefs will be supplied by AGES for each meeting incorporating the meeting theme.
- 3. The artworks will be held by AGES prior to the auction and are the property of the AGES Society until sold at auction.
- 4. One or more works from your portfolio (images only at this time) should be submitted for consideration by the judging panel. Submissions must include dimensions of original work and medium used in the work.
- 5. Ours is a women's health society, specialising in surgery and this may guide entry, although all works will be considered.
- 6. AGES will retain the license for the use of the image (of the artwork) for the promotion of the following events; AGES FM 2024, AGES BPFS 2024 & AGES ASM 2025.
- 7. The Artist and artwork will be recognised by AGES as the winning recipient of the 2024/25 AGES Art Society prize across AGES's various platforms (including but not limited to AGES; Facebook, Twitter, Instagram, website and e-blasts).
- 8. The <u>closing date for submissions is: Tuesday 31st August 2023 at 5.00pm AEST</u> with the first commissioned work to be produced and delivered by 17th December 2023 (schedule below).
- 9. All submissions are to be emailed to the AGES Secretariat at ages@yrd.com.au with the subject line AGES Society Art Prize Submission. Large files should be sent via Dropbox link or WeTransfer (https://www.wetransfer.com/)
- 10. Applications that do not follow the specified application format will not be accepted (see page 3)
- 11. The winning artist will be required to submit their commissioned work as per the schedule on page. 4. High quality digital images will need to be supplied to AGES that are a true representation of the artwork.
- 12. The Artist is responsible for preparing the work to be hung and/or displayed and the packaging of all the artwork for transport. AGES will arrange the transfer of the artwork.
- 13. The 3x commissioned pieces of art must each be a minimum of 100 x 100cm in size.

- Artist statement 50 100 words
- Photo of work/s
- Description of all submitted works (title, dimensions, medium, description of work/concept)

IMAGE REQUIREMENTS

It is preferred that the submitted images are not framed, crooked, show backgrounds, or have watermarks.
