

AGES SOCIETY RESEARCH FUND GRANTS TO AGES MEMBERS – TRAINEES & YOUNG FELLOWS CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS: 2023 GRANTS

The AGES Society Research Fund endorses and supports research from Trainees and New College Fellows (< 5 years post award of Fellowship). The Research Committee is pleased to announce the opening of submissions for a **metanalysis or systematic review** in the area of gynaecological surgery or its directly associated areas leading to publication from eligible candidates. The aim of this grant is to promote structured and meaningful research to study an area of the gynaecological literature for the Society and greater peer group. There is the possibility of two grants of up to \$5,000 will be awarded for 2023.

Applicants should provide the following information:

- 1. Proposed project outline
- 2. Full Curriculum Vitae
- 3. Name and contact details of supervising gynaecologist or FRANZCOG Supervisor
- 4. Letter of support from supervisor or Departmental Head
- 5. Budget and justification (note that travel costs for meeting presentations may not be included in the budget)

Grants may be awarded for RANZCOG approved projects. The trainee will need to demonstrate a major role in the study, and will need a FRANZCOG supervisor. If it is anticipated that the grant recipient will not be in Australia to complete the grant, then his/her supervisor is to be the primary investigator in the application.

Successful applicants should note that the research must be completed within 12 months of the award being granted. Funds will not be transferred until the work has been submitted and accepted for publication.

The closing date for submissions is **Wednesday 31st August 2022**.
